

OPEN AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIPS CONDITIONS of PLAY

- Open to all amateur women golfers holding current Golf Australia handicaps.
- Only affiliated Members of an RWGA affiliated Club are eligible to win a *closed* event.
- All players must present their GolfLink card if requested.
- The *Rules of Golf*, RWGA *Standard Conditions of Play* and host club's *Local Rules* are the rules of play.
- A player's handicap on Day 1 of play shall prevail over 36 and 54 hole handicap events for the Championships.
- Any reduction or increase in daily handicaps will apply in 18 hole daily events.
- Tied scores in Division One of a Major Event (Scratch score), the winner will be decided by a playoff over 3 holes as decided by the match committee. If still tied, sudden death playoff over the same 3 holes until a winner is declared.
- Play-off holes to be determined and announced by Match Committee prior to tee off day one.
- Tied Divisional winners to be decided by countback system.
- A seeded draw will be done for Wednesday with the top eight scratch scores over all divisions. Players ranked 1 – 4 will play in the first group and Players ranked 5 – 8 will play in the second group.
- Match Committee reserves right to make alteration/s before any event should it be deemed advisable.
- PRACTICE on course between rounds is prohibited (Rule 5.2b).
- All protests to be submitted, in writing, within 30 minutes after close of play.
- The decision of the Match Committee on all points and protests shall be final.
- Motorised Cart: Cart hire will be the player's responsibility. Cart sharers *must* be in same Division.
- Mobile phones must be off or in silent mode. Disciplinary action may be taken in accordance with *Section 1: Etiquette of the Rules of Golf*. Mobile phone use accepted only in an emergency situation.
- Remaining in defined recording area protects player from disqualification for not signing score card.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Closed Event: affiliated Members of an RWGA affiliated Club eligible

Open Event: GA affiliated players eligible

Veteran: 50-69 years and Super Veteran: 70+ years

Players must be affiliated with NSW Women's Veterans Association to be eligible to win these divisions.

O'Halloran-Bult Shield

- Three players representing more than one club with less than 25 members at each club
- Total of scores on Monday and Tuesday
